## Cleaning and Disinfecting Computer Equipment

Always clean before disinfecting.

## **CLEANING**

- 1. Turn off and unplug your computer.
- 2. If you have a laptop, turn it upside down, while it's open and tap or shake it to dislodge debris. If you have a desktop, follow the same steps with your keyboard and mouse only.
- 3. Use a soft-bristled brush to wipe and clean loose debris from between the keys of your keyboard.
- 4. Wipe across the keys with a lightly damp microfiber cloth.
- 5. If any stubborn grimy spots remain, use a cotton swab dipped in a bit of isopropyl alcohol.

## **DISINFECTING**

- 1. Apply a liquid disinfectant to a cloth and use that cloth to wipe down the computer. Don't spray or apply liquid cleaners directly to any part of your computer.
- 2. You can use disinfectant wipes if they are not dripping. Squeeze the wipe to remove any excess moisture before wiping the computer to avoid damaging your device.
