

Attachment III: Training Initial Eligibility Performance Requirement Scenarios

Scenario.7; A school with a campus in New Mexico and in several other states is newly approved to be on New Mexico's ETPL and submits a program for initial eligibility.

The program is new to both the school and new to the ETPL, so the school has no performance data to report specifically for that program.

Performance.information.required.for.initial.eligibility;

No performance information is required; initial eligibility is approved for one year, provided all other information is correctly entered in application

Scenario.8; A school with a campus in New Mexico and in several other states is newly approved to be on New Mexico's ETPL.

They submit a program for initial eligibility. The program has been offered at the school for several years, so they have a lot of performance to report. It is old for the school but new to New Mexico's ETPL.

Performance.information.required.for.initial.eligibility;

The most recent performance information for the program that covers a minimum of one year.

Scenario.9; A provider with a campus only in New Mexico is newly approved to be on New Mexico's ETPL.

They submit a program for initial eligibility. The program has been offered at the school for several years, so they have a lot of performance to report. It is old for the school but new to the State ETPL.

Performance.information.required.for.initial.eligibility;


The most recent performance information for the program that covers a minimum of one year.

Scenario.0: A trainer with a campus in New Mexico only is newly approved to be on New Mexico's ETPL.

The program is new to both the school and new to the ETPL, so the school has no performance data to report specifically for that program

Performance.information.required.for.initial.eligibility:

Information related to the cumulative performance for all of the training provider's programs in New Mexico. This is an example from another school's website:

Scenario.1: A school from Texas with no physical presence in New Mexico wants to offer an online training program to WIOA customers.

They submit a program for initial approval. The program has been offered at the online trainer for several years, so they have a lot of performance to report. It is old for the school but new to New Mexico's ETPL.

Performance.information.required.for.initial.eligibility:

To approve the training provider: Performance information related to the cumulative performance for all of the training provider's programs for a minimum of one year.

To approve the program: Performance information related to the specific online course, reported as an aggregate number for the online course in all states.

Scenario. 2. A school from Georgia with no physical presence in New Mexico wants to offer an online training program to WIOA customers.

They Submit an online program for initial eligibility. The program has never been offered by the trainer, so they have no performance to report. It is new both the school and New Mexico's ETPL.

Performance information required for initial eligibility?

To approve the training provider: No performance information is required, and initial eligibility is approved for one year, provided all other information is correctly entered in the application.

Training Provider Licensing Requirements: Other considerations should include the training provider licensing requirements found in **OWDI 03-2020**.
