FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE SUB RECIPIENT AGREEMENT No. PY19-WIOA-02 BETWEEN SOUTHWESTERN WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD AND RESCARE WORKFORCE SERVICES

This Contract Amendment to the Grant Agreement ("Agreement") is between the <u>Southwestern Workforce Development Board (LWDB)</u>, and <u>Rescare Workforce Services (SUBRECIPIENT)</u> under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Adult & Dislocated Worker Program.

WHEREAS, LWDB and SUBRECIPIENT are parties to the Agreement effective as of July 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the LWDB has reviewed the SUBRICIPIENT'S budget adjustment; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement contains provisions to allowing the modification of the Agreement when agreeable to both parties; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the forgoing premises, the LWDB and SUBRECIPIENT agree to the following on the effective date of this Contract Amendment, which is on the most recent date of signature of the LWDB and SUBRECIPIENT;

1. Budget Amount

(a) Attachment A – Budget is removed from the current contract agreement and replaced with Attachment A-1 Amended Budget.

Attachment A-1 reflects that:

- i. The WIOA Adult funds is <u>increased</u> in the amount of \$1,190,642.00 from \$1,560,000.00 to \$2,750,642.00; and the total amount of Dislocated Worker funds is <u>decreased</u> in the amount of \$1,190,642.00 from \$2,007,000.00 to \$816,358.00.
- ii. The total contract amount of \$3,567,000.00 remains unchanged.

2. Modification

(a) Except as modified by this Amendment, the terms and conditions of the Agreement, remain in full force and effect.
